Highlights from the Last Quarter

• Participation and Exhibition at the World Bank Land Conference:

Vastpoint partnered with the World Bank at the World Bank Land Conference held this May in

Washington D.C. to present the **Mapping Land, Mapping Culture** art exhibition.

The exhibition was inspired by communitydrawn maps from rural communities Mozambique, created as part of the World Bankfunded **Terra** Segura project. where VASTPOINT was tasked with surveying issuing over 750,000 individual land titles and 300 more than

community titles—positively impacting over 3 million people across seven provinces.

Our team recognized the beauty and cultural significance embedded in these community maps, which capture local values, resources, and aspirations. Drawing on their richness, we launched an art challenge, inviting African artists to reinterpret these landscape drawings and transform their cultural narratives into works of art. The goal was to create pieces that offer new perspectives and raise awareness of the importance of land security for a broad and diverse audience.

The winning artworks were reimagined by artist **Bruno Sserunkuma**, who transformed the original sketches into clay vessels and printed textiles, blending African oral traditions with contemporary reflections on land, equity, and economic transformation. This innovative exhibition received an enthusiastic response!







• Successful Projects:

Vastpoint was selected to conduct a land survey in the area of Marcory (a municipality of Abidjan autonomous district), Cote d'ivoire for the International Finance Corporation. We're proud to have been part of their journey.



The mission was to characterize the plots, define their areas, identify their owners and the title deeds held on these plots and analyze the issues encountered during the survey. Innovative communication and awareness methods were used to engage the communities encompassing the important yet generally ignored social and cultural aspects of land titles.

Ongoing and New projects:

Systematic Land Adjudication and Certification Contract (SLAAC) Phase 2 in **Uganda** under The World Bank's Competitiveness and Enterprise Development Project consisting of communication and awareness, demarcation of parish boundaries, land use planning, demarcation of individual plots, and processing of land titles for about 40,000 land parcels in the provinces of Soroti, Serere, and Bukedea.

Vastpoint has been recently awarded the following projects:

- Contract to secure the rights of holders of customary rights and holders of usage rights on land in the Rural Land Domain in the PRESFOR intervention zones in two (2) regions of **Côte d'Ivoire** covering over 500,000 hectares in a joint venture with CGE Sotti from Ivory Coast under The World Bank's Program for Strengthening of Rural Land Security (PRESFOR)
- Three lots of Subdivision survey of the collective CLOAS for issuance of individual CLOAS 2024 (about 33,000 Ha, about 1000 land holdings) in **Philippines** under The World Bank's Support to Parcelization of Lands for Individual Titling Project (Project SPLIT)

• Participation in the UNIDO Accelerate-to-Demonstrate (A2D) Facility Conference:

We were honored to participate in the UNIDO Accelerate-to-Demonstrate (A2D) Facility Conference in Nairobi this May and speak at the "Investing in Inclusion: Gender Lens Innovation for a Just Energy Transition" panel. We showcased how land management can serve as a powerful lever for advancing gender equity and expanding access to clean energy, especially when Gender Equality and Social Inclusion practices and Environmental and Social Safeguards are integrated early in the project







lifecycle. We are deeply grateful to UNIDO and the A2D Facility team for the invitation and for fostering a platform where land, energy, and equity intersect to drive transformational change.
